

Falcon Ridge Board Approved Clubs

Effective 3/8/2013

Clubs seeking board approval to use the clubhouse must meet the following criteria:

- The majority of members must be Falcon Ridge residents
- Clubs must have a minimum of 6 members
- Must have a specific purpose (a general social gathering is not considered a club. The clubhouse may be rented for general social gatherings)
- Must require the use of the clubhouse for meetings
- Clubs meet once a month on the same day each month – Monday thru Thursday (Friday, Saturday and Sunday are reserved for rentals)
- Meeting days and times are on a first come first served basis
- Club meeting days and times must be consistent each month
- Clubs must meet at least 8 months in a calendar year
- Clubs who miss more than 5 monthly meetings in a calendar year will lose board approved status and will no longer be able to use the clubhouse as a club
- No clubs of a religious, political or business nature are permitted.
- All board approved clubs, current and future, must be open to the participation of all Falcon Ridge residents
- Homeowners organizing a club, meeting at the clubhouse, must be residents in good standing with no fines or delinquent assessments with the Association.

Clubs who have board approved status prior to the effective date of this document should operate as they have in the past.

TO OBTAIN BOARD APPROVED STATUS

Clubs who wish to have “board approved status” should email the following information to the board secretary.

1. Name of club
2. Club’s purpose
3. Number of members
4. Number of members who are Falcon Ridge residents
5. Club’s contact person’s
 - a. Name
 - b. Address
 - c. Phone number
 - d. Email address
6. Day of the month and time of day requested for meeting (see website or clubhouse bulletin boards for available days and times)

The board will review the information at the next regularly scheduled board meeting and will then contact the club’s contact person with its decision. *Please be advised, that all criteria listed above, must be met in order to qualify for board approval.*
